

Oral Health Promotion Research Group, Ireland Dental Health Foundation Bursary Criteria 2022

Background

The **Oral Health Promotion Research Group, Ireland**, [OHPRG] is pleased to extend a bursary sponsored by the **Dental Health Foundation** of up to €1,000 for 2022. The OHPRG is awarding the bursary this year to promote the communication of current oral health promotion projects and work that is going on across Ireland.

Criteria for application for the bursary.

Applications are accepted from individuals or teams. Applicants should describe a recent or planned oral health promotion project in which they have been involved. The format of the application should include the following headings:

- Title / Introduction
- Background
- Aims and objectives
- Materials and methods
- Results (if available)
- Discussion and conclusion
- Acknowledgements
- Costs (for projects at the planning / roll out stage)
- Max word count 1,200
- All applications should be founded on a sound evidence-base.

The work should not have been presented elsewhere nor have been awarded a prize previously. If you have previously submitted an application and were unsuccessful why not review and re-apply.

Applicants from the HSE must have the permission of their line manager to submit the proposal and the submission must bear the signature of the line manager.

Applications will be judged by members of the Committee of the OHPRG. The Committee reserves the right to withhold the bursary if applications do not meet the submission criteria. The decision of the judges is final. The winning applicant will be notified by e-mail no later than Monday, 26th September 2022.
